ORDER ON PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO SERVE PROCESS BY PUBLICATION PURSUANT TO 15 U.S.C. § 1125(D)(2)(A)(ii)

This matter comes before the Court on Plaintiff's Motion to Serve Process by Publication Pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1125(d)(2)(A)(ii) and to Set a Date Certain for Defendant Adjog.com to Respond to the Complaint. Dkt. 11. The Court has considered the relevant documents and the remainder of the file herein.

This case is an *in rem* action against a domain name, adjog.com, brought pursuant to the Anticybersquatting Consumer Protection Act ("ACPA"), 15 U.S.C. § 1125(d). Dkt. 1. Plaintiff moves to serve Defendant by publication and have the Court set a date for the Defendant to respond to the Complaint. Dkt. 11.

Plaintiff's motion to serve the Defendant by publication should be granted. It has shown that it has exercised due diligence in attempting to find a "person who would have been a defendant" as contemplated in 15 U.S.C. § 1125(d)(2)(A)(ii)(II)(bb), and should be permitted to serve process by publication in accord

with the provisions in the ACPA. *Id.* If Plaintiff chooses to proceed, it should publish a legal notice once a week for six consecutive weeks in the proposed Maryland newspaper *The Daily Record* in accord with Washington's service of process by publication statute RCW 4.28.110.

Plaintiff's motion regarding setting a date certain for Defendant to respond to the Complaint in the legal notice should be granted. The date certain should be set in accord with RCW 4.28.110.

III. ORDER

Therefore, it is hereby, **ORDERED** that:

- Plaintiff's Motion to Serve Process by Publication Pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1125(d)(2)(A)(ii) and to Set a Date Certain for Defendant Adjog.com to Respond to the Complaint (Dkt. 11) should be GRANTED; service by publication and the date certain shall be made in accord with RCW 4.28.110; and
- The Clerk is directed to send uncertified copies of this Order to all counsel of record and to any party appearing *pro se* at said party's last known address.
