- 8. The use of the infringing mark by Defendants is without consent of the Plaintiff, who is the owner of the Registrations. Plaintiff has also sought to resolve this by agreement to which the defendants have not meaningfully responded. Such use thus constitutes trademark infringement because such use is likely to cause confusion, or to cause mistake, or to deceive. Defendants' use of the infringing mark is thus in violation of 15 U.S.C. § 1114.
- 9. Defendants' continued use of the infringing mark has and is causing irreparable harm to Plaintiff, and will continue to cause irreparable harm and economic loss to Plaintiff unless Defendants cease all use of the infringing mark.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

2	10.	WHI	EREFORE, Plaintiff requests this Court for the following judicial relief:
3		a.	An injunction enjoining Defendant from continuing to use the infringing
4			mark in connection with their goods and services;
5		b.	An order from the court ordering Defendant to transfer ownership of the
6			domain name "alliedfiresprinklers.com" to Plaintiff, or in the alternative
7			to order it immediately inaccessible and permanently enjoin use of such
8			domain name;
9		c.	An order from the court ordering Defendant to deliver up and destroy al
10			labels, signs, prints, packages, wrappers, receptacles, and advertisements
11			in the possession of the Defendant, bearing the infringing mark, and all
12			plates, molds, matrices, and other means of making the same;
13		d.	Award of Defendant's profits resulting from use of the infringing mark
14		e.	Award of damages sustained by Plaintiff as a result of Defendant's use
15			of the infringing mark;
16		f.	Award of Plaintiff's costs of this action;
17		g.	Award of attorney fees as deemed appropriate by the Court; and
