1 damage in the form of damage to plaintiff's reputation and goodwill, lost business  
2 opportunities, the alienation of customers, and time and expense spent fielding complaints  
3 about DSS' investor solicitations. In addition, based on the same record, it appears plaintiff  
4 and plaintiff's counsel have made sufficient efforts to contact DSS with regard to the  
5 underlying dispute and, specifically, to provide DSS with notice of the present motion and with  
6 copies of the motion and supporting documents.

7 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

8 1. Defendant Detex Security Systems, Inc., its officers, directors, principals,  
9 agents, representatives, servants, employees, successors and assigns and all others in active  
10 concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this order, by personal service  
11 or otherwise, are directed not to take the following action:

12 a) Use the DETEX name on Pink Sheets or in any trading or sales of stock,  
13 whatsoever;

14 b) Maintain, operate or otherwise display the "detexsec.com" domain;

15 c) Use the DETEX name on communications, faxes, e-mail, domain names,  
16 products, lines of businesses, services, or in any other public form;

17 d) Use the DETEX name to identify itself.

18 2. Defendant Detex Security Systems shall appear before this Court on  
19 May 19, 2006 at 11:15 (a.m./p.m.), Superior Court of Washington for King County,  
20 and show cause why the activity described above should not continue to be restrained during  
21 the pendency of this action.

22 3. The Order contained in paragraph 1 above shall expire at the date and time set  
23 forth in paragraph 2 above, unless extended by further order of this Court.
