In addition, based on the same record, it appears plaintiff and plaintiff's counsel have made sufficient efforts to contact DSS with regard to the underlying dispute and, specifically, to provide DSS with notice of the present motion and with copies of the motion and supporting documents.

- 2. Defendant Detex Security Systems shall appear before this Court on May 19,2006 at 11:15 (a.m.)/p.m., Superior Court of Washington for King County, and show cause why the activity described above should not continue to be restrained during the pendency of this action.
- 3. The Order contained in paragraph 1 above shall expire at the date and time set forth in paragraph 2 above, unless extended by further order of this Court.
