Plaintiff Microsoft Corporation ("Microsoft") hereby alleges as follows:

INTRODUCTION

1. This is an action by Microsoft to recover damages arising from infringement of Microsoft's copyrights and trademarks by defendants, and to enjoin defendants' future infringements. Defendants are actively engaged in trafficking counterfeit copies of Microsoft software. In addition to damages and injunctive relief, Microsoft seeks an accounting, the imposition of a constructive trust upon defendants' illegal profits, and other injunctive relief.

COMPLAINT FOR DAMAGES AND
EQUITABLE RELIEF - 1

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1 **THE PARTIES**

2 2. Plaintiff Microsoft is a Washington corporation with its principal place of
3 business in Redmond, Washington. Microsoft develops, markets, distributes, and licenses
4 computer software.

5 3. Defendant Carlos Sandoval is a citizen of California. Defendant Sandoval
6 distributes computer software on the Internet using, among other methods, the auction site
7 eBay (www.ebay.com). On this auction site and in his sales, defendant uses fictitious
8 business names or aliases including "minervasfurn."

9 4. Microsoft is unaware of the true names and capacities of defendants sued
10 herein as John Does 1 - 10 and therefore sues these defendants by such fictitious names.
11 Microsoft will amend this complaint to allege their true names and capacities when
12 ascertained. Microsoft is informed and believes and therefore alleges that each of the
13 fictitiously named defendants is responsible in some manner for the occurrences herein
14 alleged, and that Microsoft's injuries as herein alleged were proximately caused by such
15 defendants.

16 5. The actions alleged herein to have been undertaken by Sandoval and John
17 Does 1-10 (collectively "defendants") were undertaken by each defendant individually, were
18 actions that each defendant caused to occur, were actions that each defendant authorized,
19 controlled, directed, or had the ability to authorize, control or direct, and/or were actions in
20 which each defendant assisted, participated or otherwise encouraged, and are actions for
21 which each defendant is liable. Each defendant aided and abetted the actions of the
22 defendants set forth below, in that each defendant had knowledge of those actions, provided
23 assistance and benefited from those actions, in whole or in part. Each of the defendants was
24 the agent of each of the remaining defendants, and in doing the things hereinafter alleged, was
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1 acting within the course and scope of such agency and with the permission and consent of
2 other defendants.

3 **JURISDICTION AND VENUE**

4 6. This Court has personal jurisdiction over the defendants, who are primary
5 participants in tortious acts in, and directed to, Washington, and have purposely availed
6 themselves of the opportunity to conduct commercial activities in this forum.

7 7. This Court has subject matter jurisdiction over Microsoft's claims for
8 trademark infringement, copyright infringement, and related claims pursuant to 15 U.S.C.
9 § 1121, 17 U.S.C. § 501, and 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331 and 1338(a).

10 8. Venue is proper in the Western District of Washington pursuant to 28 U.S.C.
11 § 1391(b), because a substantial part of the events giving rise to Microsoft's claims occurred
12 in this District.

13 **FACTS COMMON TO ALL CLAIMS**

14 9. Microsoft develops, advertises, markets, distributes, and licenses a number of
15 computer software programs. Microsoft's software programs are recorded on CD-ROMs, and
16 they are packaged and distributed together with associated proprietary materials such as user
17 guides, user manuals, end-user license agreements ("EULAs"), and other items.

18 10. Microsoft's Products: Microsoft has developed, advertised, marketed,
19 distributed, and licensed the software packages known as Microsoft Office 2007 and
20 Microsoft Office 2003 Professional:

21 a. Microsoft Office 2007. Microsoft Office 2007 Ultimate ("Office 2007") is a
22 suite of popular Microsoft software programs. Microsoft holds a valid copyright in Office
23 2007 (including user reference manuals, user guides, and screen displays) that was duly and
24 properly registered with the United States Copyright Office. A true and correct copy of the
25 Registration Certificate for Office 2007, bearing number TX 6-504-552, is attached as
26

1 **Exhibit 1** and is incorporated by reference.¹ Office 2007 includes the following popular
2 Microsoft software programs:

3 i. Microsoft Access 2007, a program that allows users to create and
4 manipulate databases and to store data. Microsoft holds a valid copyright in Microsoft Access
5 2007 (including user reference manuals, user guides, and screen displays) that was duly and
6 properly registered with the United States Copyright Office. A true and correct copy of the
7 Copyright Registration Certificate for Microsoft Office Access 2007, bearing number TX 6-
8 524-395, is attached as **Exhibit 2** and is incorporated by reference.

9 ii. Microsoft Excel 2007, a program that allows users to create and
10 manipulate spreadsheets, perform calculations, and store numerical data. Microsoft holds a
11 valid copyright in Microsoft Excel 2007 (including user reference manuals, user guides, and
12 screen displays) that was duly and properly registered with the United States Copyright
13 Office. A true and correct copy of the Copyright Registration Certificate for Microsoft Office
14 Excel 2007, bearing number TX 6-524-399, is attached as **Exhibit 3** and is incorporated by
15 reference.

16 iii. Microsoft Groove 2007, a program that allows users to collaborate
17 remotely to streamline business processes and content management. Microsoft holds a valid
18 copyright in Microsoft Groove 2007 (including user reference manuals, user guides, and
19 screen displays) that was duly and properly registered with the United States Copyright
20 Office. A true and correct copy of the Copyright Registration Certificate for Microsoft Office
21 Groove 2007, bearing number TX 6-524-390, is attached as **Exhibit 4** and is incorporated by
22 reference.

23 iv. Microsoft InfoPath 2007, a program that allows users to develop and
24 deploy dynamic electronic forms. Microsoft holds a valid copyright in Microsoft InfoPath

1 2007 (including user reference manuals, user guides, and screen displays) that was duly and
2 properly registered with the United States Copyright Office. A true and correct copy of the
3 Copyright Registration Certificate for Microsoft Office InfoPath 2007, bearing number TX 6-
4 524-392, is attached as **Exhibit 5** and is incorporated by reference.

5 v. Microsoft OneNote 2007, a program that allows users to create
6 electronic notebooks to easily organize, search, and share notes. Microsoft holds a valid
7 copyright in Microsoft OneNote 2007 (including user reference manuals, user guides, and
8 screen displays) that was duly and properly registered with the United States Copyright
9 Office. A true and correct copy of the Copyright Registration Certificate for Microsoft Office
10 InfoPath 2007, bearing number TX 6-524-396, is attached as **Exhibit 6** and is incorporated by
11 reference.

12 vi. Microsoft Outlook 2007, a program that allows users and networked
13 teams to create and manage calendars, tasks, contacts, and email communications. Microsoft
14 holds a valid copyright in Microsoft Outlook 2007 (including user reference manuals, user
15 guides, and screen displays) that was duly and properly registered with the United States
16 Copyright Office. A true and correct copy of the Copyright Registration Certificate for
17 Microsoft Office Outlook 2007, bearing number TX 6-524-393, is attached as **Exhibit 7** and
18 is incorporated by reference.

19 vii. Microsoft PowerPoint 2007, a program that allows users to create,
20 organize, and present overhead and slide presentations. Microsoft holds a valid copyright in
21 Microsoft PowerPoint 2007 (including user reference manuals, user guides, and screen
22 displays) that was duly and properly registered with the United States Copyright Office. A
23 true and correct copy of the Copyright Registration Certificate for Microsoft Office
24 PowerPoint 2007, bearing number TX 6-524-389, is attached as **Exhibit 8** and is incorporated
25 by reference.
26

1 viii. Microsoft Publisher 2007, a desktop publishing program that allows
2 users to create, customize, and publish materials such as newsletters, brochures, flyers,
3 catalogs, and Web sites. Microsoft holds a valid copyright in Microsoft Publisher 2007
4 (including user reference manuals, user guides, and screen displays) that was duly and
5 properly registered with the United States Copyright Office. A true and correct copy of the
6 Copyright Registration Certificate for Microsoft Office Publisher 2007, bearing number TX
7 6-524-388, is attached as **Exhibit 9** and is incorporated by reference.

8 ix. Microsoft Word 2007, a program that allows users to create and edit
9 reports and documents. Microsoft holds a valid copyright in Microsoft Word 2003 (including
10 user reference manuals, user guides, and screen displays) that was duly and properly
11 registered with the United States Copyright Office. A true and correct copy of the Copyright
12 Registration Certificate for Microsoft Office Word 2007, bearing number TX 6-524-398, is
13 attached as **Exhibit 10** and is incorporated by reference.

14 b. Microsoft Office 2003. Microsoft has developed, advertised, marketed,
15 distributed, and licensed a software package known as Microsoft Office 2003 Professional
16 ("Office 2003"). Office 2003 is a suite of popular Microsoft software programs. Microsoft
17 holds a valid copyright in Office 2003 (including user reference manuals, user guides, and
18 screen displays) that was duly and properly registered with the United States Copyright
19 Office. A true and correct copy of the Registration Certificate for Office 2003, bearing
20 number TX 5-837-617, is attached as **Exhibit 11** and is incorporated by reference. Office
21 2003 includes the following popular Microsoft software programs:

22 i. Microsoft Access 2003, a program that allows users to create and
23 manipulate databases and to store data. Microsoft holds a valid copyright in Microsoft Access
24 2003 (including user reference manuals, user guides, and screen displays) that was duly and
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1 properly registered with the United States Copyright Office. A true and correct copy of the
2 Copyright Registration Certificate for Microsoft Access 2003, bearing number TX 5-901-713,
3 is attached as **Exhibit 12** and is incorporated by reference.

4 ii. Microsoft Excel 2003, a program that allows users to create and
5 manipulate spreadsheets, perform calculations, and store numerical data. Microsoft holds a
6 valid copyright in Microsoft Excel 2003 (including user reference manuals, user guides, and
7 screen displays) that was duly and properly registered with the United States Copyright
8 Office. A true and correct copy of the Copyright Registration Certificate for Microsoft Excel
9 2003, bearing number TX 5-837-636, is attached as **Exhibit 13** and is incorporated by
10 reference.

11 iii. Microsoft Outlook 2003, a program that allows users and networked
12 teams to create and manage calendars, tasks, contacts, and email communications. Microsoft
13 holds a valid copyright in Microsoft Outlook 2003 (including user reference manuals, user
14 guides, and screen displays) that was duly and properly registered with the United States
15 Copyright Office. A true and correct copy of the Copyright Registration Certificate for
16 Microsoft Outlook 2003, bearing number TX 5-900-087, is attached as **Exhibit 14** and is
17 incorporated by reference.

18 iv. Microsoft PowerPoint 2003, a program that allows users to create,
19 organize, and present overhead and slide presentations. Microsoft holds a valid copyright in
20 Microsoft PowerPoint 2003 (including user reference manuals, user guides, and screen
21 displays) that was duly and properly registered with the United States Copyright Office. A
22 true and correct copy of the Copyright Registration Certificate for Microsoft PowerPoint
23 2003, bearing number TX 5-852-649, is attached as **Exhibit 15** and is incorporated by
24 reference.

25 v. Microsoft Word 2003, a program that allows users to create and edit
26

1 reports and documents. Microsoft holds a valid copyright in Microsoft Word 2003 (including
2 user reference manuals, user guides, and screen displays) that was duly and properly
3 registered with the United States Copyright Office. A true and correct copy of the Copyright
4 Registration Certificate for Microsoft Word 2003, bearing number TX 5-900-088, is attached
5 as **Exhibit 16** and is incorporated by reference.

6 vi. Microsoft Publisher 2003, a desktop publishing program that allows
7 users to create, customize, and publish materials such as newsletters, brochures, flyers,
8 catalogs, and Web sites. Microsoft holds a valid copyright in Microsoft Publisher 2003
9 (including user reference manuals, user guides, and screen displays) that was duly and
10 properly registered with the United States Copyright Office. A true and correct copy of the
11 Copyright Registration Certificate for Microsoft Publisher 2003, bearing number TX 5-837-
12 618, is attached as **Exhibit 17** and is incorporated by reference.

13 11. Microsoft has also duly and properly registered a number of trademarks and
14 service marks in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on the Principal Register.
15 Microsoft uses these marks to identify its products and services in the marketplace. Among
16 the marks owned by Microsoft are the following registered marks (collectively the "Microsoft
17 Marks"): ACCESS, EXCEL, GROOVE, INFOPATH, MICROSOFT, ONENOTE,
18 OUTLOOK, and POWERPOINT.

19 12. Since at least November 1992, Microsoft has used, in commerce, the
20 trademark "ACCESS" to promote to promote general-purpose computer database software.

21 13. On February 2, 2005, Microsoft applied for the registration of the ACCESS
22 trademark. United States Trademark Registration No. 3,238,869 was issued on May 8, 2007.
23 See **Exhibit 18**. The ACCESS trademark is broadly recognized as a brand identifier for
24 general-purpose computer database software and related products.

25 14. Since at least September 30, 1985, Microsoft has used, in commerce, the
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1 trademark "EXCEL" to promote spreadsheet software and related products.

2 15. On April 12, 2004, Microsoft applied for the registration of the EXCEL
3 trademark. United States Trademark Registration No. 2,942,050 was issued on April 19,
4 2005. *See Exhibit 19.* The EXCEL trademark and service mark is broadly recognized as a
5 brand identifier for Microsoft's spreadsheet software and related products.

6 16. Since at least October 24, 2000, Microsoft has used, in commerce, the
7 trademark "GROOVE" to promote content management software and related products.

8 17. On October 18, 2000, Microsoft applied for the registration of the GROOVE
9 trademark. United States Trademark Registration No. 2,830,702 was issued on April 6, 2004.
10 *See Exhibit 20.* The GROOVE trademark and service mark is broadly recognized as a brand
11 identifier for Microsoft's content management software and related products.

12 18. Since at least February 19, 2003, Microsoft has used, in commerce, the
13 trademark "INFOPATH" to promote electronic forms software.

14 19. On January 8, 2003, Microsoft applied for the registration of the INFOPATH
15 trademark. United States Trademark Registration No. 2,890,260 was issued on September 28,
16 2004. *See Exhibit 21.* The INFOPATH trademark and service mark is broadly recognized as
17 a brand identifier for Microsoft's forms software and related products.

18 20. Since at least November 12, 1975, Microsoft has used, in commerce, the
19 trademark and service mark "MICROSOFT" to promote its products and services.

20 21. On October 22, 1979, Microsoft's predecessor applied for the registration of
21 the MICROSOFT trademark and service mark. United States Trademark Registration No.
22 1,200,236 was issued on July 6, 1982. The MICROSOFT trademark and service mark is also
23 the subject of United States Trademark Registration Nos. 1,966,382, 2,250,973, and
24 2,285,870. *See Exhibit 22.* Microsoft's MICROSOFT trademark and service mark is
25 broadly recognized as identifying plaintiff Microsoft and its various products and services.
26

1 22. Since at least March 6, 2003, Microsoft has used, in commerce, the trademark
2 "ONENOTE" to promote electronic notebook software and related products.

3 23. On November 6, 2002, Microsoft applied for the registration of the ONENOTE
4 trademark. United States Trademark Registration No. 2,844,710 was issued on May 25, 2004.
5 See **Exhibit 23**. The ONENOTE trademark and service mark is broadly recognized as a
6 brand identifier for Microsoft's electronic notebook software and related products.

7 24. Since at least January 1, 1997, Microsoft has used, in commerce, the trademark
8 "OUTLOOK" to promote computer software and electronic communications services.

9 25. On February 5, 1996, Microsoft applied for the registration of the OUTLOOK
10 trademark. United States Trademark Registration No. 2,188,125 was issued on September 8,
11 1998. See **Exhibit 24**. The OUTLOOK trademark is broadly recognized as a brand identifier
12 for Microsoft's computer software and electronic communications services.

13 26. Since at least April 20, 1987, Microsoft has used, in commerce, the trademark
14 "POWERPOINT" to promote computer presentation software.

15 27. On June 29, 1987, Microsoft applied for the registration of the POWERPOINT
16 trademark. United States Trademark Registration No. 1,475,795 was issued on February 9,
17 1988. See **Exhibit 25**. The POWERPOINT trademark is broadly recognized as a brand
18 identifier for Microsoft's presentation software.

19 28. The Microsoft Marks are distinctive and, as a result of Microsoft's substantial
20 investment, they have developed extensive goodwill in the market. Accordingly, the
21 Microsoft Marks are extremely valuable to Microsoft.

22 23 **DEFENDANTS' INFRINGEMENT**

24 29. Beginning at a time unknown and continuing to the present, defendants have
25 actively engaged in the illegal and unlawful business of advertising, distributing, and selling
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1 counterfeit copies of computer software, including programs covered by Microsoft's
2 registered copyrights and bearing Microsoft's registered trademarks or imitations thereof.

3 30. Defendants advertise and distribute counterfeit copies of Microsoft software in
4 interstate commerce on the Internet by using, among other channels, the Internet auction site
5 eBay (www.ebay.com). Defendants conduct some of their online sales under the seller
6 identification "minervasfurn."

7 31. Microsoft investigators conducted initial purchases of one or more units of the
8 programs Office 2007 and Office 2003 through eBay from an internet seller who, upon
9 information and belief, was owned or operated by defendants. After analyzing the software
10 media received from defendants, Microsoft determined they were counterfeit copies.

11 32. Following this initial purchase, Microsoft notified defendants that they were
12 selling counterfeit copies of Microsoft software and demanded that defendants cease and
13 desist their infringing activity.

14 33. Despite this demand, defendants continued to sell counterfeit copies of
15 Microsoft software. After giving defendants notice of their counterfeit sales, Microsoft
16 purchased from defendants, through direct email, one or more additional units of Office 2003.
17 Microsoft again analyzed the software media received from defendants and determined they
18 were counterfeit copies.

19 34. Defendants' continued distribution and sale of counterfeit copies of Microsoft
20 software has caused and is continuing to cause consumers to be confused, mistaken or
21 deceived about the authenticity of Microsoft products distributed by defendants. Defendants'
22 wrongful conduct has caused and is continuing to cause harm to Microsoft's business
23 reputation and goodwill.

24 35. Defendants' violations are willful, deliberate, and committed with prior notice
25 and knowledge of Microsoft's copyrights and registered marks. Defendants' wrongful
26

1 conduct has caused and continues to cause significant and irreparable harm to Microsoft.
2 Microsoft brings this action to recover damages for the harm it has sustained, to impose a
3 constructive trust upon defendants' illegal profits and assets purchased with those profits, and
4 to obtain injunctive relief prohibiting defendants' further violations and infringements.
5
6

7 **FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION**

8 **(Copyright Infringement, 17 U.S.C. §§ 501 et seq.)**

9 36. Microsoft repeats and incorporates by this reference each and every allegation
10 set forth in paragraphs 1 through 35, inclusive.

11 37. Microsoft is the sole owner and licensor of the software programs identified
12 in paragraph 10 above, as well as other software covered by Microsoft's registered
13 copyrights and bearing Microsoft's registered trademarks or imitations thereof, and of all
14 corresponding copyrights and Certificates of Registration.

15 38. Defendants have infringed the copyrights in Microsoft's software, including,
16 but not limited to those identified in paragraph 10 above, as well as other software covered
17 by Microsoft's registered copyrights and bearing Microsoft's registered trademarks or
18 imitations thereof, by distributing infringing materials in the United States of America,
19 without approval or authorization from Microsoft.

20 39. Defendants' conduct has been willful within the meaning of the Copyright
21 Act. At a minimum, defendants acted with willful blindness to and in reckless disregard of
22 Microsoft's registered copyrights.

23 40. As a result of their wrongful conduct, defendants are liable to Microsoft for
24 copyright infringement. Microsoft has suffered, and will continue to suffer, substantial
25 losses, including, but not limited to, damage to its business reputation and goodwill.
26

1 Microsoft is entitled to recover damages, which include its losses and all profits defendants
2 have made as a result of their wrongful conduct, pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 504(b).

3 41. Alternatively, Microsoft is entitled to statutory damages pursuant to 17
4 U.S.C. § 504(c). In addition, because defendants' infringement has been willful within the
5 meaning of the Copyright Act, the award of statutory damages should be enhanced pursuant
6 to 17 U.S.C. § 504(c)(2).

7 42. Microsoft is also entitled to injunctive relief enjoining defendants' wrongful
8 conduct pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 502 and an order impounding all infringing materials
9 pursuant to 17 U.S.C. §§ 503 and 509(a). Microsoft has no adequate remedy at law for
10 defendants' wrongful conduct because, among other things: (a) Microsoft's copyrights are
11 unique and valuable property which have no readily determinable market value;
12 (b) defendants' infringement harms Microsoft's business reputation and goodwill such that
13 Microsoft could not be made whole by any monetary award; and (c) defendants' wrongful
14 conduct, and the resulting damage to Microsoft, is continuing.

15 43. Microsoft is also entitled to recover its attorneys' fees and costs of suit
16 pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 505.

17 **SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION**

18 **(Trademark Infringement, 15 U.S.C. §§ 1114 et seq.)**

19 44. Microsoft repeats and incorporates by this reference each and every allegation
20 set forth in paragraphs 1 through 43, inclusive.

21 45. Defendants' activities constitute infringement of Microsoft's federally
22 registered trademarks and/or service mark in violation of the Lanham Act, including, but not
23 limited to, 15 U.S.C. § 1114(1).

24 46. Because Microsoft advertises, markets, distributes, and licenses its software
25 under the trademarks and/or service mark described in this Complaint, these trademarks
26

1 and/or service mark are the means by which Microsoft's software is distinguished from the
2 software or products of others in the same field or related fields.

3 47. Because of Microsoft's long, continuous, and exclusive use of these
4 trademarks and/or service mark, they have come to mean, and are understood by customers,
5 end users, and the public to signify software or services of Microsoft.

6 48. Defendants' wrongful conduct includes the distribution of counterfeit copies
7 of Microsoft software with unauthorized reproductions of registered Microsoft trademarks
8 and/or service mark. The infringing materials that defendants have and are continuing to
9 use, offer, advertise, market, install or distribute are likely to cause confusion, mistake or
10 deception as to their source, origin or authenticity.

11 49. Defendants' activities are likely to lead the public to conclude, incorrectly,
12 that the infringing materials that defendants are using, advertising, installing, marketing,
13 offering or distributing originate with or are authorized by Microsoft, to the damage and
14 harm of Microsoft, its licensees, and the public.

15 50. Defendants used, offered, advertised, marketed, installed or distributed
16 infringing material with the willful and calculated purposes of (a) misleading, deceiving or
17 confusing customers and the public as to the origin and authenticity of the infringing
18 materials and (b) trading upon Microsoft's business reputation and goodwill. At a minimum,
19 defendants acted with willful blindness to and in reckless disregard of Microsoft's registered
20 marks.

21 51. As a result of their wrongful conduct, defendants are liable to Microsoft for
22 trademark infringement. Microsoft has suffered, and will continue to suffer, substantial
23 losses, including, but not limited to, damage to its business reputation and goodwill.
24 Microsoft is entitled to recover damages, which include its losses and all profits defendants
25 have made as a result of their wrongful conduct, pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1117(a).
26

1 52. Alternatively, Microsoft is entitled to statutory damages pursuant to 15
2 U.S.C. § 1117(c). In addition, because defendants' infringement of Microsoft's trademarks
3 and/or service mark was willful, within the meaning of the Lanham Trademark Act, the
4 award of damages and profits should be trebled pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1117(b).

5 53. Microsoft is also entitled to injunctive relief enjoining defendants' wrongful
6 conduct pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1116(a), and to an order impounding all infringing materials
7 pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1116, subsections (a) and (d)(1)(A). Microsoft has no adequate
8 remedy at law for defendants' wrongful conduct because, among other things:

9 (a) Microsoft's trademarks and/or service mark are unique and valuable property which have
10 no readily determinable market value; (b) defendants' infringement constitutes harm to
11 Microsoft's business reputation and goodwill such that Microsoft could not be made whole
12 by any monetary award; (c) if defendants' wrongful conduct is allowed to continue, the
13 public is likely to become further confused, mistaken or deceived as to the source, origin or
14 authenticity of the infringing materials; and (d) defendants' wrongful conduct, and the
15 resulting damages to Microsoft, is continuing.

16 54. Microsoft is also entitled to recover its attorneys' fees and costs of suit
17 pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1117.

18 **THIRD CAUSE OF ACTION**

19 **(False Designation of Origin, 15 U.S.C. §§ 1125 *et seq.*)**

20 55. Microsoft repeats and incorporates by this reference each and every allegation
21 set forth in paragraphs 1 through 54, inclusive.

22 56. Because Microsoft advertises, markets, distributes, and licenses its software
23 under the trademarks and/or service mark described in this Complaint, these trademarks
24 and/or service mark are the means by which Microsoft's software is distinguished from the
25 software or products of others in the same or related fields.
26

1 57. Because of Microsoft's long, continuous, and exclusive use of these
2 trademarks and/or service mark, they have come to mean, and are understood by customers,
3 end users, and the public to signify software or services of Microsoft.

4 58. Microsoft has designed distinctive and aesthetically pleasing displays, logos,
5 icons, graphic images, and packaging (collectively, "Microsoft visual designs") for its
6 software programs.

7 59. Defendants' wrongful conduct includes the use, advertising, marketing,
8 offering or distribution of Microsoft's marks, name, and/or imitation visual designs
9 (specifically displays, logos, icons, graphic designs, and/or packaging) that are virtually
10 indistinguishable from Microsoft's visual designs, in connection with their goods and
11 services.

12 60. Defendants engaged in such wrongful conduct with the willful purpose of
13 (a) misleading, deceiving or confusing customers and the public as to the origin and
14 authenticity of the goods and services offered, marketed or distributed in connection with
15 Microsoft's marks, name, and imitation visual designs and (b) trading upon Microsoft's
16 business reputation and goodwill.

17 61. Defendants' conduct constitutes (a) false designation of origin, (b) false or
18 misleading description, and (c) false or misleading representation that the imitation visual
19 design originate from or are authorized by Microsoft, all in violation of section 43(a) of the
20 Lanham Trademark Act, set forth at 15 U.S.C. § 1125(a).

21 62. Defendants' wrongful conduct is likely to continue unless restrained and
22 enjoined.

23 63. As a result of defendants' wrongful conduct, Microsoft has suffered and will
24 continue to suffer substantial losses, including, but not limited to, damage to its business
25 reputation and goodwill.

1 64. Microsoft is entitled to injunctive relief enjoining defendants' wrongful
2 conduct pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1125(a), and to an order impounding all imitation visual
3 designs being used, offered, advertised, marketed, installed or distributed by defendants.
4 Microsoft has no adequate remedy at law for defendants' wrongful conduct because, among
5 other things; (a) Microsoft's marks, names, and visual designs are unique and valuable
6 property, which have no readily determinable market value; (b) defendants' advertising,
7 marketing, installation or distribution of imitation visual designs constitutes harm to
8 Microsoft's business reputation and goodwill such that Microsoft could not be made whole
9 by any monetary award; and (c) defendants' wrongful conduct, and the resulting damage to
10 Microsoft, is continuing.

11 65. Microsoft is also entitled to recover its attorneys' fees and costs of suit
12 pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1117.

13 **FOURTH CAUSE OF ACTION**

14 **(Constructive Trust Upon Illegal Profits)**

15 66. Microsoft repeats and incorporates by this reference each and every allegation
16 set forth in paragraphs 1 through 65, inclusive.

17 67. Defendants' acts and conduct constitute deceptive, fraudulent, and wrongful
18 conduct in the nature of passing off the counterfeit copies of infringing software as approved
19 or authorized by Microsoft.

20 68. By virtue of defendants' wrongful acts and conduct, defendants have illegally
21 received money and profits that rightfully belong to Microsoft.

22 69. Microsoft is also entitled, pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1117(a) and 17 U.S.C.
23 § 504(b), to recover all profits of defendants that are attributable to their acts of infringement
24 or violations thereof.

1 70. Upon information and belief, defendants hold the illegally received money
2 and profits in the form of bank accounts, real property, and personal property (including
3 motor vehicles) that can be located and traced.

4 71. Defendants hold the money and profits they illegally received as constructive
5 trustee for the benefit of Microsoft.

6 **FIFTH CAUSE OF ACTION**

7 **(Accounting)**

8 72. Microsoft repeats and incorporates by this reference each and every allegation
9 as set forth in paragraphs 1 through 71, inclusive.

10 73. Microsoft is entitled, pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1117(a) and 17 U.S.C. § 504(b),
11 to recover all profits of defendants that are attributable to their acts of infringement or
12 violations thereof.

13 74. The amount of money due from defendants to Microsoft is unknown to
14 Microsoft and cannot be ascertained without a detailed accounting by defendants of the
15 precise number of units of infringing material offered for distribution and distributed by
16 defendants.

17 **PRAYER FOR RELIEF**

18 WHEREFORE, Microsoft respectfully requests judgment as follows:

- 19 1. That the Court enter a judgment against defendants finding that they have:
- 20 a. willfully infringed Microsoft's rights in federally registered copyrights;
- 21 b. willfully infringed Microsoft's rights in federally registered trademarks
22 and/or service mark;
- 23 c. committed and is committing acts of false designation of origin, false
24 or misleading description of fact, and false or misleading representation against Microsoft;
25 and
26

1 d. otherwise injured the business reputation and business of Microsoft by
2 the acts and conduct set forth in this Complaint;

3 2. That the Court issue permanent injunctive relief against defendants, and that
4 defendants, their agents, representatives, servants, employees, attorneys, successors and
5 assigns, and all others in active concert or participation with defendants, be enjoined and
6 restrained from:

7 a. imitating, copying or making any other infringing use or infringing
8 distribution of the software and/or materials protected by Microsoft's copyrights, registered
9 trademarks, and/or service mark;

10 b. manufacturing, assembling, producing, distributing, offering for
11 distribution, circulating, selling, offering for sale, advertising, importing, promoting or
12 displaying any software, item or thing bearing any simulation, reproduction, counterfeit, copy
13 or colorable imitation of software, item or thing protected by Microsoft's copyrights,
14 registered trademarks, and/or service mark;

15 c. using any simulation, reproduction, counterfeit, copy or colorable
16 imitation of Microsoft's registered copyrights, registered trademarks, and/or service mark, in
17 connection with the manufacture, assembly, production, distribution, offering for distribution,
18 circulation, sale, offering for sale, import, advertisement, promotion or display of any
19 software program, item, and/or thing not authorized or licensed by Microsoft;

20 d. using any false designation of origin or false or misleading description
21 or false or misleading representation that can or is likely to lead the trade or public
22 erroneously to believe that any software program, item or thing has been manufactured,
23 assembled, produced, distributed, offered for distribution, circulation, sold, offered for sale,
24 imported, advertised, promoted, displayed, licensed, sponsored, approved or authorized by or
25 for Microsoft, when such is not true in fact;
26

1 e. using reproductions, counterfeits, copies or colorable imitations of
2 Microsoft's copyrighted and trademark protected software and other materials in the
3 distribution, offering for distribution, circulating, sale, offering for sale, advertising,
4 importing, promoting or displaying of any merchandise not authorized or licensed by
5 Microsoft;

6 f. using the names, logos, or other variations thereof, of any of
7 Microsoft's copyright and/or trademark-protected software in any of the defendants' trade or
8 corporate names;

9 g. engaging in any other activity constituting an infringement of any of
10 Microsoft's trademarks, service mark, and/or copyrights or of Microsoft's rights in or right to
11 use or to exploit, these trademarks, service mark, and/or copyrights; and

12 h. assisting, aiding or abetting any other person or business entity in
13 engaging in or performing any of the activities referred to in subparagraphs a through g
14 above.

15 3. That the Court enter an order impounding all counterfeit copies and infringing
16 Microsoft software and/or materials bearing any of Microsoft's trademarks or service mark or
17 any Microsoft documentation or packaging, and any related items, including business records,
18 that are in defendants' possession or under defendants' control, and ordering the remedial
19 destruction of all impounded items.

20 4. That the Court enter an order declaring that defendants hold in trust, as
21 constructive trustee for the benefit of Microsoft, all "profits" received by defendants from
22 their distribution or sale of counterfeit and infringing Microsoft software and/or materials, and
23 issue temporary, preliminary and permanent injunctive relief enjoining and restraining
24 defendants and their agents from transferring, concealing or dissipating all profits and assets
25 acquired in whole or in part with those profits.
26

1 5. That the Court enter an order requiring defendants to provide Microsoft a full
2 and complete accounting of all profits received by defendants from their distribution or sale of
3 counterfeit and infringing Microsoft software and/or materials, and of any other amounts due
4 and owing to Microsoft as a result of defendants' illegal activities.

5 6. That the Court order defendants to pay Microsoft's general, special, actual, and
6 statutory damages, including defendants' profits, for defendants' willful infringement of
7 Microsoft's copyrights, registered trademarks, and/or service mark.

8 7. That the Court order defendants to pay to Microsoft the costs of this action and
9 the reasonable attorneys' fees incurred by Microsoft in prosecuting this action.

10 8. That the Court grant to Microsoft such other and additional relief as is just and
11 proper.

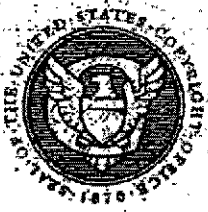

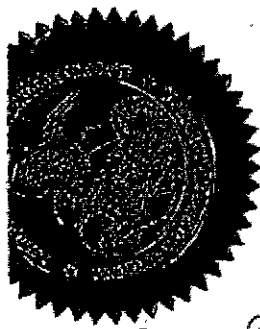
