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Moonray Espresso Corporation ("Moonray") (collectively "Defendants"), and states and alleges as follows:

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- 1. This action is for trademark infringement and unfair competition arising under the Trademark Act of 1946, as amended ("The Lanham Act"), 15 U.S.C. § 1051, et seq., as well as for trademark infringement and unfair competition under the laws of the state of Washington.
- 2. This Court has jurisdiction over Counts I and II of this Complaint pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1121 because this is an action arising under the Lanham Act and under 28 U.S.C. § 1338(a) because this is an action arising under an Act of Congress relating to trademarks; and under 28 U.S.C. § 1331 because this is an action arising under the laws of the United States. This Court has supplemental jurisdiction over Counts III and IV of this Complaint pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1338(b) because it is an action asserting claims of common law trademark infringement and unfair competition and joined with substantial and related claims under the trademark laws of the United States.
 - 3. Venue lies in this District pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1391(b) and (c).
- 4. All conditions precedent to the filing of this action have been performed, occurred, or are excused.

THE PARTIES

5. Moonstruck is a corporation duly organized under the laws of the state of Oregon and maintains its primary place of business in Portland, Oregon. Moonstruck is an established and nationally-known manufacturer, distributor, marketer and seller of chocolate and chocolate-related products. Moonstruck sells its branded products and provides its services throughout the United States.

- 6. Upon information and belief, Snow is an individual residing in the state of Washington and in this District. Snow operates a retail business known as Moonray Espresso Corporation in Duvall, Washington, selling coffee, coffee drinks, other beverages, pastries and other food items, including chocolate.
- 7. Snow and Moonray reside and transact business in the state of Washington and the acts of infringement and other wrongful acts alleged in this Complaint arose in the state of Washington.

FACTS

- 8. Moonstruck was established in 1993. It sells chocolates all over the United States online, through select gournet food retailers, including gournet food retailers in the state of Washington and through Moonstruck's own company-owned cafes. Excerpts from the Moonstruck website are attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit A.
- 9. Moonstruck now operates several company-owned chocolate cafes, including four in the state of Oregon.
- 10. Moonstruck sells its products to numerous retailers in the state of Washington and this District, including several in the greater Seattle area.
- 11. Moonstruck maintains high standards and exercises strict quality control measures in relation to the quality and reputation of the gourmet food retailers to whom it sells it chocolates for resale.
- 12. Moonstruck uses a number of trademarks to identify its goods and services, including the names and marks MOONSTRUCK; MOONSTRUCK CHOCOLATE, MOONSTRUCK CHOCOLATIER, and its distinctive "Moon" design mark:

13. Moonstruck is the owner of several U.S. Trademark Registrations, including:

- Reg. No. 1,855,897 MOONSTRUCK CHOCOLATIER for
 "cakes and dessert cakes, cheesecakes, pies, bundt cakes, chocolates, chocolate toppings and hand-dipped chocolates, tarts, tartlets, barquettes, pastries, strudels, cookies, brownies, candy bars, jambles; namely, shortbread cookies with preserves or chocolate as a topping, petit fours, bread rolls, truffles and hand-dipped truffles, caramels and hand-dipped caramels, paves, tortes, sheetcakes."
- Reg. No. 1,861,090 "Moon Design" for "cakes and dessert cakes, cheesecakes, pies, bundt cakes, chocolates, chocolate toppings and hand-dipped chocolates, tarts, tartlets, barquettes, pastries, strudels, cookies, brownies, candy bars, jambles; namely, shortbread cookies with preserves or chocolate as a topping, petit fours, bread rolls, truffles and hand-dipped truffles, caramels and hand-dipped caramels, paves, tortes, sheetcakes."
- Reg. No. 2,837,997 "Moon Design outline" for "Printed materials, namely, pastry bags, shopping bags, chipboard boxes, product description cards, product legend sheets, foil stickers, paper beverage napkins, point-of-sale posters, handmade keepsake boxes made of paper or cardboard"; "Earthenware mugs, paper cups, thermal insulated wrap for disposable cups to prevent scalding of the hand"; "Chocolate truffles, chocolate bars, chocolate toffee, solid chocolate

pieces, chocolate covered caramels, chocolate covered nuts, chocolate caramel and nut clusters, French butter cream chocolates, chocolate covered fruits, chocolate covered peanut butter and caramel springerle bars, chocolate bunnies filled with marshmallow, nougatine bars, chocolate mint tingles, chocolate covered blueberries, chocolate covered coffee beans, chocolate covered almonds, chocolate covered pears, pastilles, gran cru, chocolate drink base, hot cocoa powder, caramel sauce, and coffee"; "On-line ordering services featuring food, namely, candy and confectionery products, and earthenware mugs; wholesale and retail candy store and confectionery services"; "Cafe and restaurant services."

- Reg. No. 2,810,198 MOONSTRUCK CHOCOLATE CO. for "On-line ordering services featuring food, namely, candy and confectionery products, and earthenware mugs; wholesale and retail candy store and confectionery services"; "handmade keepsake boxes made of paper or cardboard."
- Reg. No. 2,812,581 MOONSTRUCK for "Printed materials, namely, paper shopping bags, chipboard boxes, product description cards, product legend sheets, foil stickers, beverage napkins of paper, point-of-sale posters, handmade keepsake boxes made of paper or cardboard"; "Earthenware mugs, paper cups, thermal insulated wrap for disposable cups to prevent scalding of the hand, pastry bags"; "Chocolate truffles, chocolate bars, chocolate toffee, solid chocolate pieces, chocolate covered caramels, chocolate covered nuts, chocolate caramel and nut clusters, French butter cream chocolates, chocolate covered fruits, springerle bars, namely, molded chocolate-covered peanut butter and caramel bars, chocolate bunnies filled with marshmallow, nougatine bars,

namely, fluffy nougat bars, chocolate mint tingles, chocolate covered blueberries, chocolate covered coffee beans, chocolate covered almonds, chocolate covered pears, pastilles, gran cru, namely, chocolate made from single-origin cocoa, chocolate drink base, hot cocoa powder, caramel sauce, and coffee"; "On-line ordering services featuring food, namely, candy and confectionery products, and carthenware mugs; wholesale and retail candy store and confectionery store services"; "Cafe and restaurant services."

• Reg. No. 2,812,593 MOONSTRUCK CHOCOLATE CAFÉ for "Printed materials, namely, paper shopping bags, point-of-sale posters, beverage napkins of paper"; "Earthenware mugs, paper cups, thermal insulated wrap for disposable cups to prevent scalding of the hand, pastry bags"; "Cafe and restaurant services"

Copies are attached and made a part hereof collectively as Exhibit B.

- 14. Moonstruck has spent a substantial amount of time and resources promoting its chocolate products, confectionary and candy products, related products including coffee and restaurant and café services offered under the MOONSTRUCK name and mark and "Moon Design" mark and related names and marks. Copies of promotional materials used by Moonstruck that prominently feature the MOONSTRUCK name and mark and the "Moon Design" mark and related marks are attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit C.
- 15. As a result of its efforts, Moonstruck has developed valuable goodwill and rights in the MOONSTRUCK name and mark. Consumers have come to recognize chocolate products, confectionary and candy products, related products including coffee and restaurant and café services offered under the MOONSTRUCK mark and the "Moon Design" mark and related marks as emanating exclusively from Moonstruck.

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- 16. Moonstruck has been the subject of much unsolicited third-party publicity in the form of news articles in printed publications and on electronic media, including publications produced in and for readers in the state of Washington, this District and the greater Seattle area. Examples of such publicity are attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit D.
- 17. As a result of Moonstruck's longstanding use of the MOONSTRUCK name and mark, the "Moon Design" mark and related marks, and a result of the public exposure garnered through sales, promotion and unsolicited gratuitous publicity, including word of mouth, the MOONSTRUCK name and mark has acquired secondary meaning and has become well and favorably known as a designator of origin for the products and café services of Moonstruck.
- 18. As a result of the duration and extent of use of the MOONSTRUCK mark in connection with Moonstruck's goods and services, the widespread geographic use of the mark and the recognition of the mark by consumers, the MOONSTRUCK name and mark has become well known in the Pacific Northwest, in the state of Washington, and this District.

DEFENDANTS' WRONGFUL ACTS

- 19. Snow contacted Moonstruck on January 20, 2006 by electronic mail requesting information regarding Moonstruck's support of "wholesale purchases and resale through other businesses (such as coffee shops)." A copy of a printout of that communication is attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit E.
- 20. Snow and Ms. Diane Gilliland of Moonstruck engaged in an exchange of electronic mails over the next few days, discussing the optimum temperature and humidity for display cases holding chocolates. Copies of printouts of these communications are attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit F.
- 21. Snow subsequently filled out a "Credit Application Agreement" and included a statement reading:

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Hello and thank you for taking the time to review our application. Below are a series of screenshots that show the location of our store, the display case we are using and a drawing of our store including the location of our display case for your chocolates.

We will be selling Espresso, bakery goods and hopefully your chocolates.

A copy of the Credit Application Agreement and associated documents, including the statement above are attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit G.

- 22. Over the next few months Ms. Gilliland of Moonstruck and Snow exchanged correspondence regarding Snow's plans to sell chocolates and related products made by Moonstruck in his soon-to-be-open café.
- 23. In late June or early July of 2006, officers of Moonstruck learned of Snow's plans to open a café selling coffees and chocolates and to use a design mark prominently featuring a moon design. Copies of photographs showing use of the MOONRAY and "Moon Design" marks sent by Snow to Moonstruck are attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit H.
- 24. Defendants have made prominent use of the designation MOONRAY and a "Moon Design" mark on signage, menus and promotional material.
- 25. Defendants have made prominent use of the designation MOONRAY and a "Moon Design" mark in commerce on its website. A copy is attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit I.
- 26. Defendants are now or have at times sold loose and boxed chocolate products, confection, pastries and other food products at their retail location.
- 27. Defendants do not have the right to use trademarks, service marks or identifiers of any kind that are confusingly similar to the **MOONSTRUCK** mark and Moonstruck's "Moon Design" mark, including the **MOONRAY** name and mark and a "Moon Design" mark.

- 28. Moonstruck has protested Defendant's infringing use of the MOONRAY name and mark and breach of the Agreement in writing. Copies of letters from counsel for Moonstruck to Defendants and counsel for Defendants are attached and made a part hereof collectively as Exhibit J.
- 29, Despite its efforts, however, Moonstruck has been unsuccessful in preventing the continued violations of its rights.
- 30. Defendants have willfully and knowingly adopted, advertised, and used the MOONRAY mark and "Moon Design" mark to identify their services for the purposes of profiting from and hijacking the goodwill of Moonstruck.
- 31. The public is likely to be misled or deceived by the false impression arising from Defendants' use of the MOONRAY mark and "Moon Design" mark.
- 32. Defendants' continuing infringing activity, demonstrates a willful and bad faith intent to create confusion, deception, and mistake in the minds of both Moonstruck's customers and potential customers and Defendants' customers and potential customers and a willful and bad faith attempt to trade on Moonstruck's goodwill by implying a similarity, identity, connection, sponsorship or relationship between Moonstruck and Defendants. As a result of this infringing activity, Defendants have been and will be unjustly enriched.
- 33. The offering for sale, the advertising for sale, and the sale by Defendants of chocolates, coffee and related products and café services under the MOONRAY mark and the "Moon Design" mark is likely to cause confusion, mistakes, and deceptions as to the source and origin of Defendants' services.

COUNT I FEDERAL TRADEMARK INFRINGEMENT

- 34. Moonstruck repeats and incorporates by reference the allegations in Paragraphs 1
 33 as if fully set forth herein.
- 35. The offering of goods and services by Defendants under the **MOONRAY** mark and "Moon Design" mark is likely to cause confusion amongst consumers with the services of Moonstruck.
- 36. Defendants' use of the **MOONRAY** name and mark and "Moon Design" mark is without the permission or authorization of Moonstruck.
- 37. In view of the likelihood of consumer confusion caused by Defendants' use of the MOONRAY mark and "Moon Design" mark, Defendants' continued use of the MOONRAY mark and "Moon Design" mark is likely to cause confusion, mistake and deception among purchasers and the public generally, leading them to believe, falsely, that Defendants' goods and services are those of, sponsored or approved by, or are in some way connected with Moonstruck, to the irreparable injury of Moonstruck and of the public. Despite such a likelihood of public confusion, mistake or deception, Defendants have continued to use and are presently using the MOONRAY mark and "Moon Design" mark and disregarding Moonstruck's demand that Defendants cease this activity.
- 38. Upon information and belief, Defendants' acts complained of herein have for their objective the willful appropriation of Moonstruck's rights in its proprietary mark and of the valuable goodwill of Moonstruck's business, thereby unlawfully benefiting Defendants.

- 39. Upon information and belief, Defendants' continued use of the MOONRAY name and mark and "Moon Design" mark will be likely to injure the business and reputation of Moonstruck and will dilute the distinctive quality of Moonstruck's source identifying marks.
- 40. The acts complained of actually deceive and are likely to deceive the public into believing, falsely, that Defendants' services are those of, and are sponsored or approved by, or are in some way connected with Moonstruck, all to the irreparable injury of Moonstruck's trade and goodwill and to the injury of the public.
- 41. The aforesaid acts constitute federal trademark infringement in direct violation of 15 U.S.C. § 1132(1).

COUNT II FEDERAL UNFAIR COMPETITION

- 42. Moonstruck repeats and incorporates by reference the allegations in Paragraphs 1 41 as if fully set forth herein.
- 43. The aforesaid acts constitute federal unfair competition in the form of passing off, false representation, false advertising and false designation of origin, all in direct violation of 15 U.S.C. § 1125(a).

COUNT III WASHINGTON TRADEMARK INFRINGEMENT

- 44. Moonstruck repeats and incorporates by reference the allegations in Paragraphs 1
 43 as if fully set forth herein.
- 45. Defendants' use of the MOONRAY name and mark and "Moon Design" mark without the permission or authorization of Moonstruck is likely to cause confusion, mistake and deception among purchasers and the public generally, leading them to believe, falsely, that Defendants' goods and services are those of, sponsored or approved by, or are in some way

connected with Moonstruck, to the irreparable injury of Moonstruck and of the public. Despite such a likelihood of public confusion, mistake or deception, Defendants have continued to use and are presently using the MOONRAY mark and "Moon Design" mark and disregarding Moonstruck's demand that Defendants cease this activity.

- 46. Upon information and belief, Defendants' acts complained of herein have for their objective the willful appropriation of Moonstruck's rights in its proprietary marks and of the valuable goodwill of Moonstruck's business, thereby unlawfully benefiting Defendants.
- 47. Upon information and belief, Defendants' continued use of the MOONRAY name and mark and "Moon Design" mark will be likely to injure the business and reputation of Moonstruck and will dilute the distinctive quality of Moonstruck's source identifying mark.
- 48. The acts complained of actually deceive and are likely to deceive the public into believing, falsely, that Defendants' services are those of, and are sponsored or approved by, or are in some way connected with Moonstruck, all to the irreparable injury of Moonstruck's trade and goodwill and to the injury of the public.
- 49. The aforesaid acts constitute trademark infringement under the laws of the state of Washington.
- 50. The aforesaid acts of Defendants are greatly and irreparably damaging to Moonstruck and will continue to be greatly and irreparably damaging to Moonstruck unless enjoined by this Court, and Moonstruck is without an adequate remedy at law.

COUNT IV

WASHINGTON UNFAIR COMPETITION

51. Moonstruck repeats and incorporates by reference the allegations in Paragraphs 1
 50 as if fully set forth herein.

- 52. Defendants' use of the **MOONRAY** name and mark and "Moon Design" mark is likely to, and does, permit Defendants to "palm off" its goods and services as those of Moonstruck, which is to the detriment of Moonstruck and unjustly enriches Defendants.
- 53. On information and belief, the acts of Defendants, as heretofore alleged, have been done with the intent to deceive the public, for the purpose of misappropriation of Moonstruck's valuable goodwill and proprietary interest in Moonstruck's source-identifying MOONSTRUCK mark and "Moon Design" mark, and in undertaking such actions, Defendants have acted to cause injury to Moonstruck, all of which constitutes palming off and common law unfair competition.
- 54. The aforesaid acts of Defendants are greatly and irreparably damaging to Moonstruck and will continue to be greatly and irreparably damaging to Moonstruck unless enjoined by this Court, and Moonstruck is without an adequate remedy at law.

COUNT V ATTORNEY FEES AND EXPENSES

- 55. Moonstruck repeats and incorporates by reference the allegations in Paragraphs 1
 54 as if fully set forth herein.
- 56. As a result of Defendants' willful and malicious conduct, Moonstruck is entitled to recover the attorney fees and expenses it has incurred in bringing this action pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1117(a).

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff Moonstruck prays:

1. That Snow and Moonray and any related companies, including parents, officers, directors, agents, owners, employees, representatives and attorneys and all others acting under,

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
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
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
or in concert with them, or with any of them, be forthwith preliminarily and permanently enjoined and restrained from:


- a) using Moonstruck's proprietary and source identifying MOONSTRUCK mark and "Moon Design" mark in isolation or any colorable imitation thereof upon or in connection with Defendants' services;
- b) in any manner imitating Moonstruck's proprietary and source identifying MOONSTRUCK mark and "Moon Design" mark for the purpose of acquiring Moonstruck's trade and goodwill by imitation, fraud, mistake or deception; and
 - c) unfairly competing with Moonstruck in any manner whatsoever.
- 2. For an Order holding that Defendants' activities complained constitute Federal and Washington Trademark Infringement and Federal Unfair Competition and Common Law Unfair Competition.
- 3. For an Accounting of all Damages in the form of Defendants' profits gained as a result of their infringing acts.
- 4. For an Order directing Defendants to file with this Court and to serve upon Plaintiff Moonstruck within thirty (30) days after service of the injunction, a report, in writing, and under oath, setting forth in detail the manner and form in which Defendants have complied with the injunction and any further orders of this Court.
- 5. That Snow, Moonray and its related companies, parents, agents, employees, representatives, and all others acting under their direction or control or in concert with them, or any of them, be ordered to deliver up for destruction all advertising materials, promotional materials, flyers, signs, and any and all other materials which bear the **MOONRAY** mark and "Moon Design" mark.


