The court orders the parties to submit supplemental 20 briefing addressing (1) the jury's award of damages and (2) NPI's request for injunctive 21 relief. 22

1	The schedule for supplemental briefing is as follows:
2	(1) Gamber-Johnson shall file an opening brief no later than April 21, 2010. The
3	opening brief shall not exceed ten pages;
4	(2) NPI shall file a responsive brief no later than April 28, 2010. The response
5	shall not exceed ten pages; and
6	(3) Gamber-Johnson shall file a reply brief no later than April 30, 2010. The reply
7	shall not exceed five pages.
