

ORDER STRIKING MOTION
FOR ATTORNEY’S FEES

Before the court is Plaintiff National Products, Inc.’s (“NPI”) motion for attorney’s fees and costs (Dkt. # 255). NPI also filed a lengthy memorandum in support of its motion addressing Gamber-Johnson’s anticipated objections. On August 13, 2010, the court granted NPI’s motion for attorney’s fees and costs. (*See* Dkt. # 247 (Ruling that “[b]ecause the jury found that Gamber-Johnson’s false advertisement was done deliberately, the court awards NPI its attorney’s fees. NPI shall submit to the court a declaration setting forth its attorney’s fees and supporting documentation by no later than

1 August 30, 2010.”)). It is not clear to the court why NPI has filed a second motion for
2 attorney’s fees when its motion has already been granted. The court therefore STRIKES
3 NPI’s motion for attorney’s fees and costs (Dkt. # 255).
