

ORDER OF CIVIL CONTEMPT

THIS MATTER is before the Court on T-Mobile's Motion for Civil Contempt against George Collette. Following notice to the defendant, George Collette, a trial was scheduled for October 21, 2011 at 2:30 p.m. Plaintiff put on its first witness who testified about the actions of George Collette in violation of the Preliminary Injunction issued in this case. George Collette confessed that he violated the injunction. The Court, by clear and unequivocal evidence, finds George Collette guilty of civil contempt. The Court defers any sanction at this time. George Collette has assured this Court that he will not violate the injunction in the future. If subsequent

1 acts by George Collette, in violation of the injunction, the Court will address the issue of  
2 compensatory and coercive measures, to include the conduct which is the subject of this Order.
