ORDER

For the reasons stated in the foregoing Memorandum Opinion and the Opinion issued May 26, 2009, it is this 6th day of August, 2009, by the United States District Court for the District of Maryland, ORDERED that:

1. Beginning on January 11, 2010, Defendant, its officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, or any of them, and all persons acting in concert or participation with Defendant, or with any of the preceding, are PERMANENTLY ENJOINED AND RESTRAINED from using, for the purpose of trade or to induce the sale of goods and services, either: (i) the word OLYMPIC, by itself or in combination with any other words; or (ii) any simulation of OLYMPIC tending to cause confusion or mistake, to deceive, or to falsely suggest a connection with the USOC or any Olympic activity (including OLYMPIK or OLYMPIA). This prohibition includes, but is not limited to, using any of the foregoing on any advertising materials, signage, promotional and administrative materials, invoices, letterhead, business cards, packaging, supplies, websites, or bags.
